U Karlovcu su pod organizacijom karlovačke podružnice Hrvatskog liječničkog zbora i pod pokroviteljstvom Karlovačke županije 30. svibnja 2008. godine održani tradicionalni **XXX. svibanjski zdravstveni dani**. Nakon toga su predavanja imali prof. dr. sc. **Mijo Bergovec** "Antiagregacijska terapija u aterosklerotskoj bolesti" i prof. dr. sc. **Željko Sutlić** "Dosezi kardijalne kirurgije u Kliničkoj bolnici Dubrava".

Uslijedila su predavanja karlovačkih liječnika gdje je Dr. **Andrej Došen** imao predavanje "Redefiniranje infarkta miokarda", Dr. **Vesna Šporčić-Jelić** "Pristup bolesniku s NSTEMI-em", Dr. **Davor Horvat** "Sedam godina trajne elektrostimulacije srca u OB Karlovac" te Dr. **Sandra Jakšić-Jurinjak** "Fibrilacija atrijska u svjetlu novih smjernica". U nastavku programa su vms **Ivanka Goršić** i med. teh. **Jurica Belavić** imali predavanje "Organizacija rada u jedinici koronarne skrbi — uloga i značaj sestre".

Predavanja su bila vrlo uspješna. Cjelokupnom programu je bio nazočan veliki broj liječnika različitih specijalnosti iz cijele Karlovačke županije. Kompletni skup je bio i adekvatno medijski popraćen čime se još više naglasio njegov značaj.

Traditional XXX May health days were held on 30th May 2008 in Karlovac organized by the Karlovac subsidiary of the Croatian Medical Association sponsored by the Karlovac County. With regard to the theme they were dedicated to the 30th anniversary of Coronary Unit in the Karlovac General Hospital.

After having given a welcoming speech **Janko Grman**, MD held a lecture "Thirty years of the Coronary Unit in the Karlovac General Hospital" in which he listed the fundamental operational principles of the Coronary Unit since its foundation to date. Prof **Vjeran Nikolić-Heitzler**, MD, PhD held a lecture "Interventional management of acute myocardial infarction in Croatia", within which he also spoke about a successful organization of the *Croatian primary PCI network*. This was followed by lectures held by Prof **Mijo Bergovec**, MD, PhD "Antiaggregation therapy in atherosclerosis" and Prof **Željko Sutlić**, MD, PhD "Achievements accomplished in cardiac surgery in the Dubrava Clinical Hospital".

The lectures held by Karlovac physicians followed whereas **Andrej Došen**, MD held a lecture "Redefining of the myocardial infarction", **Vesna Šporčić-Jelić**, MD held a lecture "Approach to a patient with NSTEMI", **Davor Horvat**, MD held a lecture "Seven years of permanent electrical stimulation of the heart in the Karlovac General Hospital" and **Sandra Jakšić-Jurinjak**, MD held a lecture "Atrial fibrillation in the light of new guidelines". The whole show was continued by **Ivanka Goršić**, RN and **Jurica Belavić**, medical technician who held a lecture "Organization of work in the coronary unit — role and significance of a nurse".

The lectures were very successful. The whole show was attended by a great number of physicians from the entire Karlovac county who are specialists in different medical branches. The gathering was broadcasted by television thereby attaching more importance to it.
