Redovni stručni sastanak Hrvatskog kardiološkog društva Podružnica sjeverozapadna Hrvatska

Regular Expert Meeting of the Croatian Cardiac Society The regional branch of the north-western Croatia

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Dana 18. rujna 2009. godine održan je u Hrvatskom zagorju, u dvorcu Đalski pored Zaboka, redovni stručni sastanak Hrvatskog kardiološkog društva Podružnica sjeverozapadna Hrvatska.

Prisutno je bilo 52 članova Hrvatskog kardiološkog društva. Pozivu su se, uz članove iz podružnice, odazvali kolegice i kolege iz Rijeke, Karlovca, Siska, Zagreba i Slavonskog Broda.

Prvo predavanje "Arixtra u akutnom koronarnom sindromu" održao je Prof. dr. sc. Davor Miličić. S navedenim lijekom, kojeg primjenjujemo tijekom zadnje godine dana, već postoje i naša dobra iskustva. Prof. dr. sc. Vjeran Nikolić-Heitzler s temom o rozigitazonu kod kardioloških

On 18th September 2009, a regular meeting of the Croatian Cardiac Society of the regional branch of north-western Croatia was held in the Đalski castle near Zabok, in Hrvatsko zagorje.

There were 52 members of the Croatian Cardiac Society present. Besides the members from the regional branch, the colleagues from Rijeka, Karlovac, Sisak, Zagreb and Slavonski Brod came to the meeting.

The first lecture "Arixtra in acute coronary syndrome" was given by Prof. Davor Miličić, Ph.D. We have some good experience with the aforementioned medicine that we have been using during the last one year. Prof. Vjeran



pacijenata razjasnio je dileme treba li ovu skupinu lijekova primijeniti kod pacijenata s kardiološkim bolestima. Obzirom na dosadašnje rezultate studija, ipak se pokazalo da je rosiglitazon siguran i kod kardioloških pacijenta. Doc. dr. sc. Robert Bernat prikazao je kako u Hrvatskom zagorju liječimo i pristupamo bolesnicima s akutnim koronarnim sindromom. Bilo je riječi i o suradnji između bolnica i protokolu pacijenata s akutnim koronarnim sindromom, što se pokazalo pouzdanim u zbrinjavanju, obzirom na postotak smrtnog ishoda koji iznosi 4,9%.

Problemi se javljaju jedino kod međubolničkog transporta bolesnika a uvjetovani su činjenicom da Hrvatsko zagorje nema organiziranu Hitnu medicinsku pomoć, već samo liječnike po ambulantama u dežurstvu.

Sastanak je bio uspješan, a sudionici su bilo posebno zadovoljni s izabranim temama predavanja.

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Nikolić-Heitzler, Ph.D. speaking about use of rosiglitazone with cardiac patients and clarified some dilemmas as to whether this group of medicines should be used in patients with cardiac diseases. Considering the previous studies results, rosiglitazone was proved to be safe even with cardiac patients. Assist. Prof. Robert Bernat, Ph.D. showed how we treat and approach patients with acute coronary syndrome in Hrvatsko zagorje. We talked about cooperation among hospitals and a protocol of patients with acute coronary syndrome which proved to be reliable in management considering a percentage of mortality which amounts to 4.9%.

The problems appear only in interhospital transportation of patients and are conditioned by the fact that Hrvatsko zagorje has no organized Emergency Medical Service, but only physicians in outpatient clinics in duty.

The meeting was successful and the participants were very satisfied with the selected lecture topics.
