



## Prim. Krstačić izabran za tajnika Radne skupine "Computers in Cardiology"

**N**a upravo završenom Europskom kardiološkom kongresu u Stockholmu prim. dr. sc. Goran Krstačić iz Poliklinike za prevenciju kardiovaskularnih bolesti i rehabilitaciju iz Zagreba izabran je za tajnika Radne skupine "Computers in Cardiology".

Prim. Krstačić je član spomenute Radne skupine Europskog kardiološkog društva od 2001. godine, a od 2008. je član Nucleusa. Novi predsjednik Radne skupine postao je Dr. Enno T. van der Velde, FESC (medicinski fizičar, Dept. of Cardiology, Leiden University Medical Center), a potpredsjednik Prof. Marek Malik, FESC (kardiolog, doktor znanosti iz matematike i računarstva, St. George's Hospital and St Paul's Cardiac Electrophysiology, London).

Skupinu čini 157 članova iz cijelog svijeta, najviše iz iz Nizozemske, Italije i Njemačke, a prim. Krstačić je jedini član iz Hrvatske.

## Head Doctor Krstačić elected as Secretary of the Working Group "Computers in Cardiology"

**H**ead Doctor Goran Krstačić, PhD from the Institute for Prevention of Cardiovascular Diseases and Rehabilitation (Zagreb, Croatia) was at the European Congress of Cardiology that had been just finished, elected as the Secretary of the Working Group of "Computers in Cardiology".

Head Doctor Krstačić has been the member of this Working Group of the European Society of Cardiology since 2001 and since 2008 he has been the member of the Nucleus. Dr. Enno T. van der Velde, FESC (medical physicist, Dept. of Cardiology, Leiden University Medical Center) has become the new President of the Working Group, and the Prof. Marek Malik, FESC (Cardiologist, PhD in Mathematics and Computing, St. George's Hospital and St Paul's Cardiac Electrophysiology, London) has become Vice-President.

The Group consists of 157 members from the whole of the world whereas the greatest number of them come from Netherlands, Italy and Germany, while Head Doctor Krstačić is the only member from Croatia.
