Plaćanje članarine za Hrvatsko kardiološko društvo

Payment of the membership fee for the Croatian Cardiac Society

Upravni odbor (UO) Hrvatskoga kardiološkog društva (HKD) u nekoliko je navrata raspravljao o problemu neplaćanja članarina. Podsjećam Vas da se članarine zasigurno nisu sustavno uplaćivale od 2003. godine do danas, a vrlo vjerojatno i još nekoliko godina unatrag.

U nekoliko navrata Uprave HKD pokušale su upozoriti i potaknuti članove na plaćanje članarine, ali nažalost bez uspjeha. Naime, odgovorno mogu ustvrditi da u proteklih sedam godina nije bilo sakupljeno više od deset članarina.

U međuvremenu, kao što Vam je poznato, HKD je prešlo u najaktivnije stručno medicinsko društvo u Hrvatskoj, kako na temelju brojnih domaćih i međunarodnih skupova koje je organiziralo, tako i na temelju našega časopisa *Kardio list* koji izlazi redovito i trajno se proširuje i poboljšava, web portala www.kardio.hr koji se trajno razvija i osuvremenjuje, newslettera, zatim Hrvatskog registra hospitalnih bolesnika sa zatajivanjem srca, organiziranja Svjetskoga dana srca svake godine, opremanja štanda HKD na kongresima Europskoga kardiološkog društva (ESC), objavljivanju hrvatskoga izdanja smjernica ESC itd.

Management Board (MB) of the Croatian Cardiac Society (CCS) has discussed the problem of non-payment of membership fees on several occasions. I remind you that the membership fees have not been paid systematically since 2003 till today and most probably also a few years back.

The MB of the CCS tried to warn and motivate the members to pay the membership fee, but unfortunately without any success. In fact, I can responsibly say that in the last seven years there have not been more than ten membership fees collected.

In the meantime, as you know, CCS has grown into the most active professional medical society in Croatia, not only on the basis of numerous domestic and international congresses it organized, but also on the basis of our journal the *Kardio list* which is regularly issued and continuously expanded and improved, our web site www.kardio.hr which is continuously developed and modernized, our newsletter, the Croatian Heart Failure Registry, organization of the World Heart Day each year, preparation of the CCS stand at the congresses of the European Society of



Unatoč našim aktivnostima i projektima, HKD nije do sada imalo financijskih problema zahvaljujući izdašnim sponzorstvima i donacijama zahvaljujući kojima je naša zarada bila veća nego troškovi. Međutim, tijekom 2009. god. gospodarska kriza odrazila se i na prihode Društva koji su se bitno smanjili, pa smo mnoge aktivnosti Društva bili primorani (su)financirati iz njegovih vlastitih sredstava.

Budući da se obim naših aktivnosti tijekom ove godine nipošto neće smanjiti, nego će, naprotiv, 2010. god. biti možda i najaktivnija godina u životu našega Društva, u ime UO i osobno, lijepo Vas molim da se odazovete našem pozivu i započnete s plaćanjem članarina.

Na svojoj redovitoj sjednici održanoj 2. veljače 2010. god. UO je odlučio da se svi dosadašnji dugovi radi neplaćanja članarina izbrišu. Međutim, inzistirat ćemo da od sada uplata članarine postane jedan od neophodnih uvjeta za upis i održavanje članstva u HKD. Konkretno, započet ćemo s uplatama članarina za 2010. god, tako da se našim članovima putem trajnog naloga u računovodstvima njihovih poslodavaca omogući mjesečna uplata u iznosu od 30,00 kuna (trideset kuna).

Umirovljenici — članovi HKD oslobođeni su plaćanja bilo kakve članarine. Svi ostali trebali bi na temelju priloženog dokumenta o trajnom nalogu s računovodstvima svojih poslodavaca dogovoriti mjesečnu uplatu u iznosu od 30 kn.

U skladu s gore navedenim, lijepo Vas molim da se odazovete ovoj inicijativi kako bi se aktivnosti našega Društva mogle odvijati normalno.

In spite of our activities and projects, CCS has up to date had no financial problems due to substantial sponsorships and donations thanks to which our earnings were greater than our expenses. However, during 2009 the economic crisis was also reflected on the income of the Society which was reduced significantly, therefore we were forced to finance many of the Society activities from its own funds.

Since our activities during this year will by no means decrease, but, on the contrary, 2010 could perhaps be the most active year in the life of our Society, in the name of the MB and myself personally I kindly ask you to answer to our notification and start paying the membership fee.

At its regular meeting held on the 2nd February 2010, the MB decided to delete all the previously unpaid debts for the membership fee. However, we will insist that from now on the membership fee becomes one of the necessary prerequisites for registering and preserving the membership in the CCS. Specifically, we will start with the payment of membership fees for 2010, in such a manner that our members will have a standing payment order in the accountings of their employers which will enable a payment of a monthly fee to amount of HRK 30.00 (thirty Croatian Kuna).

The retired members of the CCS are exempt from paying the membership fee. All others should, on the basis of the attached standing payment order document, arrange a monthly payment of HRK 30 with the accountings of their employers.

In the accordance with the aforementioned, we kindly ask you to answer to this initiative, so the activities of our Society can continue.
