



## Kardiološka radionica u Općoj bolnici Dubrovnik

## Cardiac Workshop in the Dubrovnik General Hospital

U organizaciji Opće bolnice Dubrovnik 7. i 8. svibnja 2010. održana je kardiološka radionica. Mlade liječnike iz svih krajeva Republike Hrvatske dovela je renomirana tvrtka Sandoz koja je bila glavni sponzor događaja. Predavači su bili prof. dr. Vincelj, prof. dr. Zupan, doc. dr. Šikić, doc. dr. Starčević, dr. Manola i dr. Ferri Certić. Uz predavanja koja su obuhvatila akutni koronarni sindrom, resinkronizacijsku terapiju, ICD, osnove ehokardiografije, aortnu disekciju, liječenje terminalne faze srčanog popuštanja te elektrofiziologiju i RF ablaciju kao metode liječenja aritmija, videolinkom su iz invazivnog laboratorija uživo prikazivani zahvati, uz komentare invazivnih kardiologa.

Radionicu je pratilo 40 sudionika, a otvorili su je zamjenik ravnatelja Opće bolnice Dubrovnik, dr. Branko John i voditelj tečaja dr. Jerko Ferri Certić. Prikazan je razvoj kardiologije u OB Dubrovnik te je učinjena i druga percutana koronarna intervencija u Dubrovniku. Tijekom rutinskog rada u koronarnu jedinicu je primljen pacijent s akutnim infarktomiokarda sa ST-elevacijom, koji je promptno dilatiran i stentiran.

U tri dana rada invazivnog laboratorija učinjeno je preko 20 intervencija.

Dobili smo visoke ocjene za organizaciju koja ne bi bila moguća bez pomoći mnogih, kojima se ovim putem zahvaljujemo. Ekipa DuTV i gosp. Banović, uz suport tehničke službe OB Dubrovnik perfektno su odradili prijenos događaja.

Uspješna organizacija i tehničke pretpostavke su za nas jako važne jer je to bio uvod u nekoliko velikih međunarodnih kongresa koje ćemo organizirati. Prikaz završavamo s novostima i planovima kardiologije OB Dubrovnik. Tijekom svibnja će se u OB Dubrovnik implantirati i prvi ICD, a tijekom jeseni 2010. implantirat će se i dva CRT-ICD resinkronizacijska uređaja i učiniti prva transezofagijska ehokardiografija vlastitom sondom. Velika je novost i što je ravnateljstvo bolnice riješilo problem trajnog financiranja invazivne kardiologije i elektrostimulatora srca kroz mjesečni limit kojega se moramo pridržavati. Racionalnim pristupom naši bolesnici dobivaju u svom gradu vrhunsku tehniku, stentove, elektrostimulatore i drugu medicinsku tehnologiju.

Nakon edukacije vlastitog osoblja i velike pomoći kolega iz Kliničke bolnice Dubrava planiramo 2012. ući u Hrvatsku mrežu urgentne PCI te samostalno raditi, kako akutne tako i rutinske, zahvate iz područja invazivne kardiologije.

The Cardiac Workshop was held on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> May 2010 organized by the Dubrovnik General Hospital. Young doctors from all regions of the Republic of Croatia were brought by the renowned company Sandoz that was the main sponsor of this event. The lecturers were Prof. dr. Vincelj, Prof. dr. Zupan, Ass. Prof. dr. Šikić, Ass. Prof. dr. Starčević, Dr. Manola and Dr. Ferri Certić. Besides the lectures that included the acute coronary syndrome, resynchronization therapy, ICD, basics of echocardiography, aortic dissection, treatment of terminal stage of heart failure, electrophysiology and RF ablation as a arrhythmia treatment method, the procedures were live shown by using the video link accompanied made by comments by invasive cardiologists.

The Workshop was followed by 40 participants and was opened by the Deputy Principal of the Dubrovnik General Hospital Dr. Branko John and Course leader Dr. Jerko Ferri Certić. The cardiology development in the Dubrovnik General Hospital was presented and the second percutaneous coronary intervention was performed in Dubrovnik. During the routine working hours, a patient with acute ST-elevation myocardial infarction with was admitted to the coronary unit who promptly underwent dilatation and implantation of stent. In three days of the invasive laboratory operation, over 20 interventions were done.

We received high grades for the organization that would be impossible without help by many people who we thank to using this opportunity. The team DuTV and Mr. Banović, with the support of the technical unit of the Dubrovnik General Hospital did a great job in transmitting the event.

The successful organization and technical prerequisites are very important for us, since it was an introduction into several great international congresses that will be organized by us. We finish the presentation with cardiology news and cardiology plans of the Dubrovnik General Hospital. During May, the first ICD will be implanted in the Dubrovnik General Hospital, during autumn 2010 two CRT-ICD resynchronization devices will be implanted and the first transesophageal echocardiography will be done by using its own probe. It is great news that the Hospital Directorate solved a problem of permanent financing of invasive cardiology and heart electrostimulator through a monthly limit that we must comply with. Applying rational approach, our patients receive top quality technical devices, stents, electrostimulators and other medical technology in their towns.

After our staff has been trained and great help given by the colleagues from the Dubrava Clinical Hospital, we are planning to enter into the Croatian Urgent PCI Network in 2012 and independently work on not only acute, but also routine procedures in the field of invasive cardiology.
